



Chain of Responsibility (CoR)

Chain of Responsibility (CoR) training is one of the first and most important step to take to ensure you or your company are not liable under the CoR and OH&S Legislation. If you're a Consignor/Receiver, a Packer, a Loader/Unloader, a Scheduler/Operator, or a Driver, you are part of the Chain of Responsibility and you or your company could be fined!

Course Overview

The new National Transport Commission Legislation is clear. Under the new Heavy Vehicle National Law (HVNL), CoR recognises the on-road affects, inactions and demands of off road parties in the transport supply chain, and provides for their accountability. In essence, the law aims to ensure that any party in a position to control, influence or encourage particular on-road behaviour is identified and held appropriately accountable.

Course Aims and Content

Whether you drive the truck, pick up goods with a fork-lift, schedule the drivers, manually unload goods at the other end; or whether you manage the team that does, you are part of the supply chain and you could share responsibility for any legal breaches along that chain. A **Chain of Responsibility** course from Blueprint Employment and Training will give you the skills to understand the legal framework, your workplace compliance requirements, and how they apply directly to your role.

Course Duration, Delivery and Location

Pre Requisites / Entry Requirements
