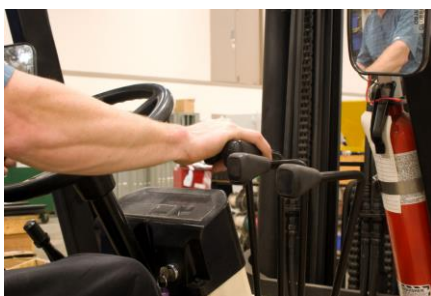
Training can be provided on site depending on minimum numbers.

Please note: all students must wear solid enclosed footwear for the duration of the course. Suitable identification must also be sighted.

Please ask about State Government funded programs, in warehousing and logistics which may be available dependant on eligibility and funding availability.

RPL (recognition of prior learning) may be available to those students who can demonstrate prior experience; knowledge and/or training. RPL applicants must also undertake the Licensing assessment.

Blueprint Employment and Training Inc offer this forklift training course option through delivery of the National Licensing Unit of Competency TLILIC2001A Licence to Operate a forklift truck (LF) at our Underwood Training Centre or with minimum numbers on your site.

This **Employer Partnership Program** option is designed to allow your employees to obtain a combination of quality training to the TLILIC2001A standard with Blueprint Inc and undertake employer directed supervision in the workplace.

The program includes a combination of self-paced study; structured training by a mixture of Blueprint accredited trainers and on-the-job employer directed supervision, followed by the formal Licensing Assessment.

The total cost of the program is \$400.00¹ per person

1. Enrolment and course commencement

- a) Payment of \$400.00 on commencement (non-refundable)
- b) All training materials provided
 - i. Forklift Workplace Health & Safety Manual
 - ii. Forklift Operations Theory Manual
 - iii. Informal Learning Record (Log book)

2. 1 Day "Face-To-Face" Theory and Practical Operations Training

- a) Conducted at Blueprint venue (or employer venue if minimum numbers provided)
- b) Training conducted with small groups
- c) Counterbalance and Reach Truck available

3. Employer lead Supervision (On-The-Job Training)

- a) Conducted by the employer by a licenced operator as required under the Work Health and Safety Regulation 2011.

4. Operational (Log book) Experience

- a) Operating experience at the workplace (supervised by a licenced operator and recorded in the Informal Learning Record - log book) between training and undertaking the licensing assessment.

5. Assessment and Licensing

- a) Blueprint require that the assessment must be undertaken within 90 days of the above training being completed²
- b) Assessment undertaken at Blueprint Employment & Training Inc or at employers premises (by negotiation).
- c) Students **MUST** be 18 years of age or over
- d) When booking Assessments a minimum of 7 working days' notice is required
- e) A cancellation fee of \$50 will apply for Assessments cancelled within 7 days of the assessment date
- f) The Licence Assessment includes a written assessment (58 short answer questions and 8 calculation questions – closed book exam) and a practical assessment component³
- g) After successful completion of the assessment applicants will be issued with:
 - i) Copy of the AS1 Assessment Notification (Assessment Summary)
 - ii) Information on the Application process
 - iii) Statement of Attainment
- h) A State Government Licence fee of \$88.40 is applicable to be paid on licence lodgment at www.worksafe.qld.gov.au
