


# Handle dangerous goods/ hazardous substances



Are you aware that employers must provide instruction and training to all employees who may be exposed to hazardous substances in the workplace in a suitable manner, and ensure that the instruction and training is adequate to address any risks identified in risk assessment?

## Course Overview

Dangerous goods and hazardous substance transport is strictly regulated in the **Australian Dangerous Goods Code** and there are heavy penalties for non compliance. Everyone involved, be they Consignors, Packers, Loaders, Vehicle Owners and Drivers, have legal responsibilities to meet in the handling and transportation of dangerous goods. All parties in the supply and distribution chain must follow state and national legal requirements, and must comply with their responsibilities in regards to packaging, labelling, segregation, loading and carrying the correct dangerous goods transport documentation.

## Course Aims

This course explains your legal responsibilities, and provides participants with the skills and knowledge to handle dangerous goods and hazardous substances in the workplace, including identifying requirements for working with them, confirming site incident procedures and selecting safe handling techniques. Topics include checking the dangerous goods load; assessing vehicle suitability to transport the intended load; checking emergency procedures and equipment; evaluating documented route plan; and completing required assessment process.

**\*Please note this course does not cover the Transport of Dangerous Goods Licence.**
