As there are limited places all applicants must attend an interview prior to enrolment.

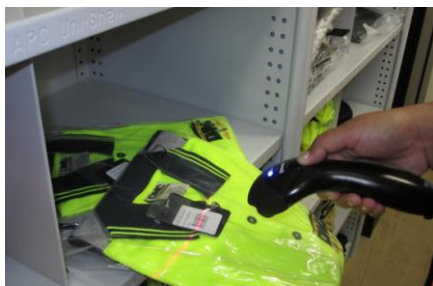
Location:

Just in Time – Skills for the Warehouse Industry (Logan)

“Just In Time” – **Skills for the Warehouse Industry** offers jobseekers the opportunity to gain nationally recognised qualifications in the **warehousing and storage industry** (Certificate II level). This Project is funded by Department of Employment, Economic Development and Innovation and is **at no cost to eligible participants**. Training is delivered in a warehouse environment – hands on and practical.

Forklift Training - 30496QLD Course in Operating Load Shifting Equipment (OHSCER207A Operate a forklift truck)

As well as warehouse training you will also have the opportunity to undertake Forklift training. New licence requirements mean that you have to undertake a formal training course and then gain 40 hours log book experience, prior to being assessed and gaining a license. This project will include formal training, however we may be unable to provide everyone with 40 hours experience. Where possible we will contribute to these hours through your experience in our simulated warehouse training venue. There are some eligibility requirements to gain a forklift licence so for more information contact Blueprint Staff.
