Targeted at leading hand and supervisor roles (13 units in total **including forklift* or order picking forklift licence*, White Card, Handling of Dangerous Goods and First Aid Training**)

Overview

Challenge's Logistics Pathways Project is funded under the Queensland Government's Skilling Queenslanders for Work Initiative and is at no cost to eligible participants.

The Skilling Queenslanders for Work Initiative focuses on supporting learners who are Queensland residents who are identified with any of the following circumstances:

- ineligible for Australian Government employment services or assistance
- require complementary services because they have significant barriers to learning and employment
- have accessed Australian Government services for more than six months and remain unemployed.

Course delivery:

Training is delivered by Blueprint (RTO: 31248) delivers full time face to face attendance at our simulated warehouse training centre at Collingwood Park.

RPL:

If students have previous experience in a warehouse environment they may be able to apply for Recognition of Prior Learning. This process may include full recognition or partial recognition with targeted "gap" training.

How will you benefit?

Challenge Employment and Training to deliver specialist Foundation Skills to assist you through your qualification should you require it and ensure you are confident and competent to enter the workforce on completion of the program. You will have the opportunity to learn and network with our highly trained and motivated supervisors while learning the skills needed to ensure you are job ready.

Support Services

A Training Plan will be developed for each student to negotiate additional support requirements. The project also includes a suite of additional support training including First Aid and White card. Students will have access to Blueprint's computers and resources including job search support. At completion of the training, students will be provided with a pair of safety boots and hi-vis safety shirt.

Eligibility Criteria

Participants must be aged 15 or older, living in Queensland and be either:

- Australian Citizen
- Permanent resident of Australia
- New Zealand citizen permanently residing in Queensland
- Refugee and Humanitarian Visa holder
- Temporary Visa Holder with the necessary visa and work permits on the pathway to permanent residency

Please note: Students must be 18 years old or older to gain a forklift licence
