Work Safely in the Construction Industry

If you want to work in the construction industry you are required by law to successfully complete a General Safety Induction course, known commonly as the "White Card".

Course Overview

Under current national workplace health and safety (WHS) legislation, workers on construction projects in Australia must undertake safety induction training or 'White Card training' before they are legally permitted to commence work onsite. White Cards are valid in all states and territories across the country.

Course Aims

The course aims to provide participants with the essential knowledge and skills to work in a range of construction sites and covers personal awareness of WHS legislative requirements, and the basic principles of risk management and prevention of injury and illness in the construction industry. Content includes understanding WHS communication and reporting processes, applying the principles of risk management and identifying common hazards and control measures.

Course Duration, Delivery and Location

We offer 1 day (9.00am to 3.00pm) **Face to Face** White Card training courses at our convenient location in Underwood. We run regular public courses or we can come to you, for a private group course at a time that suits you. Our face to face classes are very relaxed, and we aim to provide very simple and easy to understand instructions.

Course Cost

Pre Requisites / Entry Requirements

There are no formal prerequisites, however students must be 15 years of age, provide proof of identity, and are required to have sufficient English numeracy and literacy skills to read and comprehend instruction for safety on a construction workplace.

Units and Outcome

The successful achievement of this course requires you to complete CPCCWHS1001 – Work Safely in the Construction Industry. Following the successful completion of this course, you will receive a Statement of Attainment and be issued with an Occupational Health and Safety Construction Induction Card (otherwise known as the White Card).
